The Symptoms of COVID-19

Health experts have identified that the following wide range of symptoms can be potential indicators of COVID-19. If you have had any of these symptoms in the past 72 hours, we ask that you stay home and visit us at another time.

- Fever of 100.4° or higher
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- New loss of taste or smell
- Muscle pain or body aches
- Nausea or vomiting
- Congestion or runny nose
- Headaches / Dizziness
- Sore throat
- Fatigue
- Chills
- Cough

*This list does not contain all possible symptoms. Consult your medical provider for any other symptoms that are severe or concerning to you.

Guest Responsibilities

Because you play a role in not only your safety, but the safety of all guests and our staff, we ask that you follow these responsibilities during your visit:



Stay home if you are sick with any COVID symptoms.



Wearing of facemasks by guests is highly recommended. (Temporarily required in Lincoln due to City Ordinance.) Complimentary masks available at the cash registers.



Wash your hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds after using the bathroom.



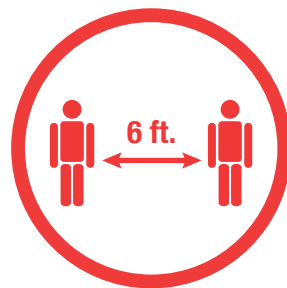
Use hand sanitizer before entering and when leaving the restaurant.

Do not touch your eyes, nose, or mouth. If you do, wash and sanitize your hands.



Maintain 6' social distancing during your visit whenever possible.
